Bishop encourages the GCJ Saints on Resurrection Sunday

FORT WALTON BEACH, FLA. – “Jesus is risen!” These were the words of Bishop Charles D. Smith, Gulf Coast Jurisdictional Bishop and Pastor of Promise Church on Resurrection Sunday, April 12, 2020, to the saints who tuned in on the Zoom Cloud Meetings App.

Because of the Coronavirus pandemic, Bishop Smith has been teaching, using Zoom, on Sunday morning, Tuesday and Friday nights, during these times of stay-at-home orders in effect in many states.



Teaching from 1 Corinthians 15:1-36, he told the saints that they must come to point where they believe and not doubt the Word of God. “Today we need to consider the bible as a reliable source for our salvation, and we need to make a decision to have a life with or without God. We must believe in the resurrection of Jesus.”

“We needed someone not under the penalty of death to die for us. God caused us to be able to share in Jesus’ death and resurrection so we could be saved. Resurrection is a newness of life and when Jesus was resurrected, everything changed—no more sacrifices of lambs because Jesus became our lamb,” said Bishop Smith.

He continued in 1 Peter 1:3-5 by saying, “We glorify God who has begotten us again from the dead by the resurrection of Jesus from the dead. We need to make up our minds that we are resurrected from the dead with Christ, let go of our old ways and do something new. We must have a resolve to obey God even though we might not change immediately.”

Bishop Smith concluded by saying, “When we come to God, we’re born again and become children of God. He answers the prayers of those who are His because He is trying to build us up to be more spiritual and productive people so we can make it to heaven.”

Effective Prayers

Praise the Lord Saints,

“Is any sick among you? Let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord: And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he hath committed sins, they shall be forgiven him. Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.” (James 5:14-16)

The easiest thing we can do is pray, and it is the cheapest fix because it doesn't cost us anything. We like to talk about prayer, but we do not want to do it. I encourage everybody to pray at least 15 minutes each day. Faithful people pray, and prayer is not positive thinking. If you learn how to pray and seek God, you will know what to do when the devil comes. The devil trains every day for battle with the saints; therefore, we need to train our minds to pray each day.

It takes practice turning our mind toward God. We have to spend time in the Word of God and learn God through the Holy Spirit. When we have a good relationship with God, we sense when we need to come before God in prayer. Prayer establishes a strong relationship with God.

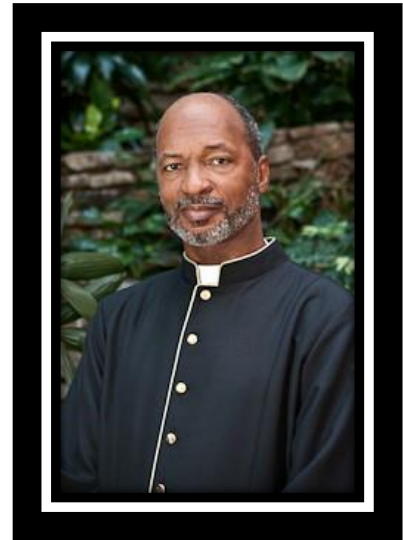

Faith in prayer means expecting God to move. God will answer a righteous man's prayer because he will pray according to God's will. There are things God wants to perform on the earth, but He is waiting on us to ask Him so He can do it.
